General Information for Permanent & Casual Stallholders



When

Markets are run every 2nd and 5th Saturday of the month all year from 7:30am to 12:30pm and only cancelled in extreme weather.

Bookings

Bookings are only required for casual stallholders. Please refer here for more information.

Price

Stalls cost \$20* for a 3m x 3m site. There are no powered sites and very few car sites available for casual stallholders.

Terms and Conditions

Safety

- Vehicles must not be moved while market is in operation between 7:30am and 12:30pm.
- All sites must be clean and clear of any trip hazards.
- Stallholders are liable for accidents relating to their stall and should carry appropriate liability insurance.

Vehicles

Stall/site Parking

If parking is not available at your site, you can arrive and unload your vehicle, however it must be moved off the market ground before 7.30 am. Please see Stallholder Parking map for where to park

You cannot drive on or off the grounds between 7.30 am and 12.30 pm

Unpacking your vehicle

We understand that the layout of the markets can lend to traffic congestion, therefore:

- please be patient and understanding with other stallholders and pedestrians
- if you do not have a car site, please unpack your vehicle and park off-site **BEFORE** setting up your stall

Public Car Parking

Please do not park in the marked spaces along the fence surrounding the market grounds. These spaces are for customers only.

Prepared Food

Prepared-food sellers must have a current Food Licence with the local council. This includes cooked food samples and dried fruit and vegetables. We are regularly visited by inspectors from Mareeba Shire Council and it is a stallholders responsibility to make sure they have the required paperwork available at all times.
